PG Bison is committed to a long-term sustainable approach to caring for and safeguarding the environment by balancing environmental considerations and social responsibility with our business goals. We are further committed to adopting environmentally responsible practices by –

- Ensuring compliance with relevant legal and other requirements;
- Improving procedures and practices continually to adapt to the dynamic environment in which we operate;
- Preventing pollution as far as practically possible; and
- Fostering environmental sustainability.

We aim to address these commitments by -

- 1. Creating awareness of our environmental values and goals in order to foster environmentally responsible citizens and future leaders;
- 2. Acting in a responsible manner in terms of air quality, greenhouse gas emissions, waste management, water and resource use, and energy efficiency by adopting the principles of 'prevent, minimise or control';
- 3. Adhering to the principle of "Reduce, Reuse and Recycle" in respect of waste management;
- 4. Monitoring water consumption and effluent-producing activities and adopting practices to conserve and reduce impact on water resources;
- 5. Monitoring energy consumption and adopting practices to improve energy efficiency and reduce energy costs;
